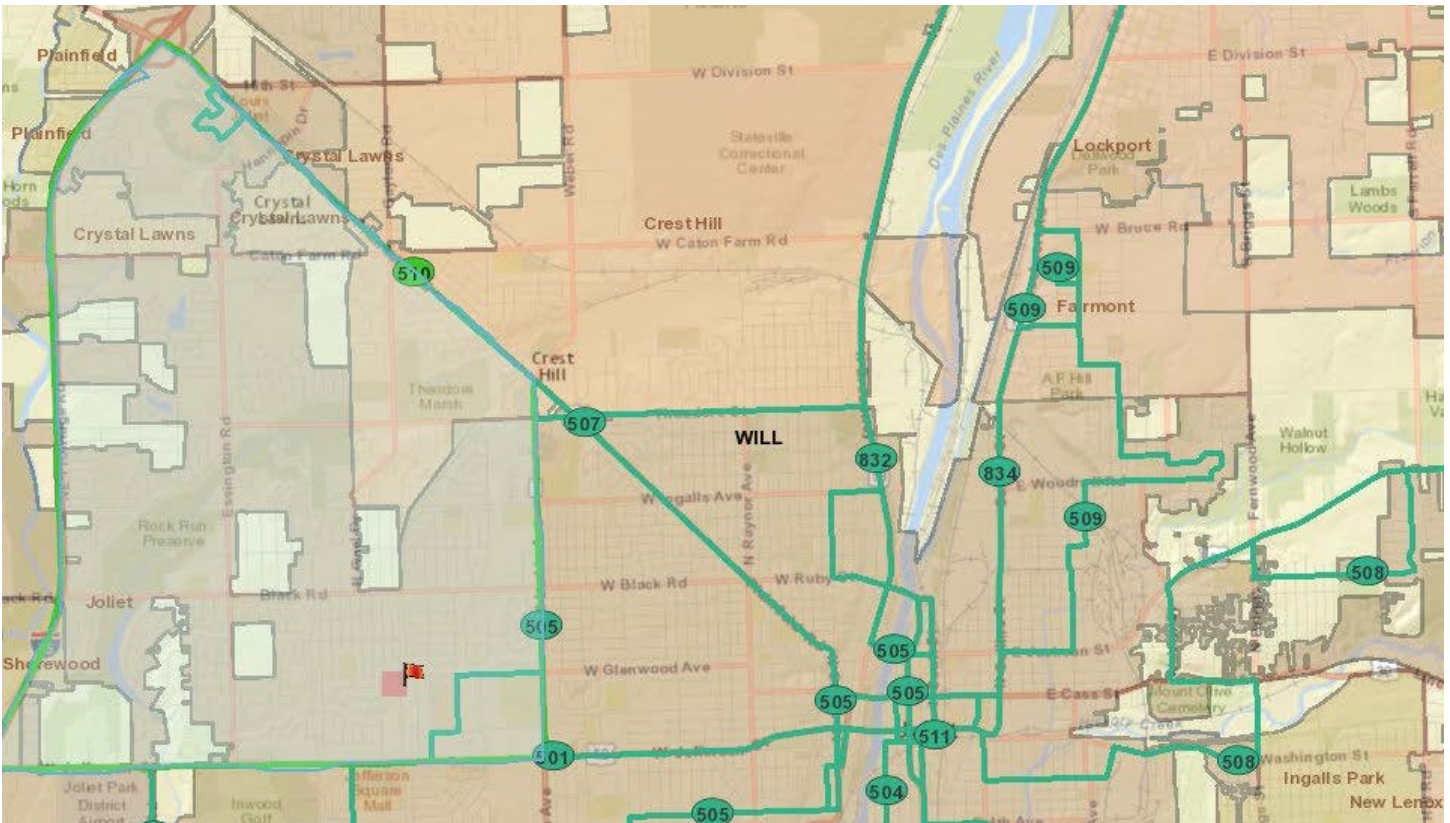

From Downtown Joliet

Take [Pace Route 505](#) from downtown Joliet in front of the Courthouse to Presence St. Joseph Hospital. The bus stops on Madison, 1 block south of Glenwood. The [West Joliet Call-n-Ride](#) connects at that stop and can drop off at the Workforce Center of Will County building. If walking is preferred, go north on Madison to Glenwood and turn left (west). The Workforce Center building is three blocks on left.

From Bolingbrook / Romeoville / Lockport

Take [Pace Route 834](#) to downtown Joliet by the Courthouse. Transfer to Route 505 and follow the above directions.

From Preston Heights area

Take [Pace Route 504](#) to downtown Joliet by the Courthouse. Transfer to Route 505 and follow the above directions.

From east of downtown Joliet

Take [Pace Route 508](#) to downtown Joliet by the Courthouse. Transfer to Route 505 and follow the above directions.

From Homer Glen

Take [Pace Route 832](#) to downtown Joliet by the Courthouse. Transfer to Route 505 and follow the above directions.

From Shorewood

Take [Pace Route 501](#) from Jewel in Shorewood at Route 59 and Jefferson east to Jefferson and Caterpillar (by Wal-Mart). Connect with either Route 505 to St. Joseph Hospital or the West Joliet Call-n-Ride.

Helpful Hints:

Call-n-Ride:

Call-n-Ride offers reservation-based, curb-to-curb, public transportation service for general public commuters traveling anywhere within the designated service area.

The fares are the same as Pace's Fixed Route Service.

All buses are equipped with a ramp or lift for wheelchair access along with equipment to secure a wheelchair inside the bus. Driver will secure the wheelchair.

Exact change is required when paying cash. If using Ventra, passenger may transfer within 2 hours to another Pace route for \$.25. Cash paying customers must pay full fare.

The drivers on the buses are able to answer questions such as where does my connection bus meet or which bus do I take. This is important in downtown Joliet because there are so many buses meeting at the same time.
