From Downtown Joliet

Take <u>Pace Route 505</u> from downtown Joliet in front of the Courthouse to Presence St. Joseph Hospital. The bus stops on Madison, 1 block south of Glenwood. The <u>West Joliet Call-n-Ride</u> connects at that stop and can drop off at the Workforce Services building. If walking is preferred, go north on Madison to Glenwood and turn left (west). The Workforce Services building is .50 miles on left.

From Bolingbrook / Romeoville / Lockport

Take <u>Pace Route 834</u> to downtown Joliet by the Courthouse. Transfer to Route 505 and follow the above directions.

From Preston Heights area

Take <u>Pace Route 504</u> to downtown Joliet by the Courthouse. Transfer to Route 505 and follow the above directions.

From east of downtown Joliet

Take <u>Pace Route 508</u> to downtown Joliet by the Courthouse. Transfer to Route 505 and follow the above directions.

From Homer Glen

Take <u>Pace Route 832</u> to downtown Joliet by the Courthouse. Transfer to Route 505 and follow the above directions.

From Shorewood

Take <u>Pace Route 501</u> from Jewel in Shorewood at Route 59 and Jefferson east to Jefferson and Caterpillar (by Wal-mart). Connect with either Route 505 to St. Joseph Hospital or the West Joliet Call-n-Ride.

- 501: Joliet Shorewood: Pace Route 501 West Jefferson
- 510: West Joliet Call-n-Ride: Pace Route 510 West Joliet Call-n-Ride

 Connection at Presence St. Joseph Hospital and Westfield Louis Joliet Mall. Serves the area bounded by I-55 on the west, Route 30 on the north, Larkin on the east and Jefferson on the south. The Call-n-Ride serves the Workforce Center of Will County. Call one hour or one day in advance for pick-up. 815-210-6960
- 504: Joliet City Center to Will County Health Department and Primary Care Center in Preston Heights: Pace Route 504 - South Joliet
- 505: Joliet City Center to St Joseph Hospital: Pace Route 505 West Joliet Loop
- 507: Joliet City Center to University of St. Francis and Westfield Louis Joliet Mall: <u>Pace Route 507 Plainfield</u>
- 508: Joliet City Center to V.A. Clinic and Silver Cross Hospital: Pace Route 508 East Joliet
- 509: Joliet City Center to Fairmont Neighborhood: Pace Route 509 Joliet Fairmont
- 511: Joliet City Center to CenterPoint Intermodal Center: Pace Route 511 Joliet Elwood Arsenal
- 832: Joliet City Center to Stateville Correctional Facility, Downtown Lockport, Homer Glen, Orland Park Metra Station at 153rd and Orland Square Mall: Pace Route 832 Joliet Orland Square
- 834: Joliet City Center to Lewis University, Promenade Bolingbrook, Downers Grove Metra Station (Metra BNSF), Good Samaritan Hospital and Yorktown Center in Lombard: Pace Route 834 Joliet Downers Grove

Helpful Hints:

Call-n-Ride:

A Call-n-Ride offers reservation-based, curb-to-curb, public transportation service for general public commuters traveling anywhere within the designated service area. See attached brochure for the Tinley Park Call-n-Ride.

The fares are the same as Pace's Fixed Route Service.

All buses are equipped with a ramp or lift for wheelchair access along with equipment to secure a wheelchair inside the bus. Driver will secure the wheelchair.

Exact change is required when paying cash. If using Ventra, passenger may transfer within 2 hours to another Pace route for \$.25. Cash paying customers must pay full fare.

The drivers on the buses are able to answer questions such as where does my connection bus meet or which bus do I take. This is important in downtown Joliet because there are so many buses meeting at the same time.
